

## COLD WEATHER PET CARE TIPS



AS TEMPERATURES BEGIN TO CHANGE, IT'S IMPORTANT TO MAKE SURE OUR FAMILY MEMBERS STAY SAFE AND COMFORTABLE. HERE ARE A FEW REMINDERS FOR ALL PET OWNERS IN OUR COMMUNITY:

### 1. KEEP PETS WARM.

IF IT'S TOO COLD FOR YOU, IT'S TOO COLD FOR THEM. LIMIT OUTDOOR TIME AND MAKE SURE PETS HAVE A WARM, DRY PLACE TO REST INDOORS.

### 2. CHECK PAWS AFTER WALKS.

SNOW, SALT, AND ICE CAN IRRITATE PAWS. WIPE THEM OFF AFTER WALKS AND CONSIDER PET-SAFE BOOTIES FOR EXTRA PROTECTION.

### 3. WATCH FOR ANTIFREEZE LEAKS.

ANTIFREEZE CAN BE DEADLY TO PETS, EVEN IN SMALL AMOUNTS. CLEAN UP SPILLS IMMEDIATELY AND KEEP CONTAINERS OUT OF REACH.

### 4. DON'T LEAVE PETS IN CARS.

COLD WEATHER CAN BE JUST AS DANGEROUS AS HEAT. CARS CAN HOLD IN THE COLD AND BECOME FREEZING QUICKLY.

### 5. OUTDOOR ANIMALS NEED EXTRA CARE.

IF PETS MUST STAY OUTDOORS, MAKE SURE THEY HAVE PROPER SHELTER, FRESH WATER THAT ISN'T FROZEN, AND EXTRA BEDDING FOR WARMTH.

### 6. MIND THEIR FOOD AND WATER.

SOME PETS MAY NEED A LITTLE MORE FOOD TO MAINTAIN BODY HEAT, BUT ALWAYS CHECK WITH YOUR VET FIRST. KEEP WATER BOWLS UNFROZEN AND CLEAN.

### 7. LOOK OUT FOR NEIGHBORHOOD ANIMALS.

CHECK UNDER YOUR CAR OR TAP YOUR HOOD BEFORE STARTING YOUR ENGINE SINCE CATS SOMETIMES SEEK WARMTH NEAR ENGINES ON COLD NIGHTS.





